Licensure Exam

- 1. **Documents to be submitted:** Application form and other documents listed on the application form
- 2. Theological Thesis Topic: <u>Discuss the biblical and theological validity</u> of the proper distinction between the covenant of works and the covenant of grace.
- 3. **Preaching:** <u>Philippians 2:5-11</u>. Submit a full manuscript for a 25 minute sermon (5-7 pages).
- 4. Exam Subjects: Christian experience and inward call to preach the Gospel, Biblical languages (Greek and Hebrew)*, Theology, Bible content, BCO <* Refer to "Remarks" below>
- 5. Oral examination and interview

Ordination Exam

- 1. **Documents to be submitted:** Application and other documents listed on the application form
- 2. Theological Thesis Topic: From a Reformed perspective, discuss how the gospel of Christ shown in God's redemptive activity in Israel's Exodus from Egypt applies to pastoral ministry. Also discuss how liberal theology interprets and applies the same event.
- 3. **Exegesis:** Exegete the Hebrew text of <u>Jeremiah 29:1-14</u> and discuss relevant theological and hermeneutical issues.
- 4. Exam Subjects: <u>The Christian life (especially in the areas of personal</u> <u>character and family management), church history including PCA</u> <u>history, sacraments</u>
- 5. Oral examination and interview

Ruling Elder Exam

- 1. Written Exams: Bible content, Westminster Confession of Faith, Larger/Shorter Catechisms, PCA Book of Church Order (BCO).
- 2. A statement of Christian experience (personal testimony)
- 3. Oral examination and interview

■ Instructions for Thesis and Exegetical Papers

- 1. Write in <u>Turabian Citation style</u> (front cover, footnote, bibliography, etc.)
- 2. Paper: Letter size (8.5 x 11), font size 11, double space, MS word document (.doc)
- 3. Number of pages: 7 pages or more for both exegesis and thesis papers

- The application forms and a list of required documents can be downloaded at <u>https://www.pcakcp.net/general</u>. If you have any questions, please contact the Stated Clerk (<u>pcakcp@gmail.com</u>).
- Once the applicant for licensure, ordination or transfer submits an official certificate of graduation (or a letter of expected graduation confirmation) and a transcript from a theological seminary, the applicant will be notified whether he is qualified to take the exams.
- Refer to BCO chapter 18 for the candidate for ministry exam, chapter 19 for the licensure exam, and chapter 21 for the ordination exam. The BCO can be downloaded at <u>www.pcaac.org/resources/bco/</u>.
- 4. The Greek and Hebrew exam requirements can be waived if the applicant took at least two semesters of each language in a theological seminary.
- 5. Written exams are take-home. When the application and required documents are all submitted a study-guide will be sent to the applicant. Once the applicant is ready to take the exams, he is to request the exam questions from the Stated Clerk.

- 6. <u>All papers and exams should be submitted to Stated Clerk by either via</u> <u>e-mail (preferred) or post mail by March 4 (Mon), which is the receive-</u> <u>by date, not the postmark date.</u>
- Examination fees: Under care (\$100), Licensure exam (\$200), Ordination exam (\$200), minister transfer (\$200) and Ruling Elder exam (\$300).

*Checks must be payable to **"Korean Capital Presbytery"** and they should be sent to the **Treasurer** by **March 4 (Mon).**
